SKYTOLL

For the first 8 months the day with the highest toll collection was 31st August

Bratislava, 17 September 2015 - In August the toll collection amounted to 14.88 million Euros.

Compared to August of the last year the collection increased by 1.12 million Euros. Toll

collection for 8 months reached 123.15 million Euros. Since the start of the year 23,407

vehicles have become entitled to a toll rate discount, of which 18,236 were from Slovakia.

The specified sections of motorways and expressways earned 9.3 million Euros on toll collection in

August. The specified sections of 1st class roads earned 5.57 million Euros in August. The vehicle

operators from abroad paid 41.4 percent of the collected tolls. The day of the month with the highest

toll collection was 31th August with the collected amount of 767,487 Euros. In August the specified

road sections were daily used by 33,508 vehicles over 3.5 tons on average.

As at 31 August 2015 there were 255,389 OBUs registered in the electronic toll system. Compared to

July their number increased by 1.694. Of the total number of OBUs 72.6 percent was used by vehicles

from abroad. In August the mobile enforcement units dealt with 511 cases of violation of Act on

Electronic Toll Collection on the specified road sections. They collected tolls from drivers in the

amount of 5,140 Euros.

In August SkyToll recorded the total of 18 justified submissions by customers concerning the

electronic toll collection operation. They included 10 complaints, 5 request and 3 suggestions. All the

justified submissions were handled within the deadline set out in the contract with the National

Motorway Company, which is 5 working days.

Operators of the customer service line of the electronic toll system received almost 4.3 thousand calls

in August while the toll web portal recorded 45.8 thousand visits for the same period.
