

## **Over 20 thousand lorries over 3.5 tons drive with discount**

**Bratislava, 18 August 2015 – The complex service of electronic toll collection earned 16.8 million Euros for the National Motorway Company in July 2015. Compared to June the amount collected decreased by 0.21 million Euros. For the seven months of this year, the toll collection reached the total of 108.27 million Euros. Since the start of the year 21,638 vehicles have become entitled to a toll rate discount, of which 17,267 have been from Slovakia.**

The toll collection on the specified sections of motorways and expressways earned 10.56 million Euros in July. Compared to June, this category of roads collected 0.8 percent less. The specified sections of 1<sup>st</sup> class roads earned 6.23 million Euros, which compared to the previous month was 1.9 percent less. Of the total amount collected 42.6 percent was paid by foreign vehicle operators. The day with the highest toll collection was 13<sup>th</sup> July with the toll revenue of 732,033 Euros. In July the specified road sections were daily used by 37,223 vehicles over 3.5 tons on average, which represented a decrease of 1,770 (4.5 %) compared to June.

As at 31 July 2015 there were 253,695 OBUs registered in the electronic toll system. Compared to the previous month their number increased by 1,827 units. Of these 72.5 percent was used by foreign vehicles. In the course of July the mobile enforcement units dealt with 639 cases of violation of Act on Electronic Toll Collection on the specified road sections. They collected tolls from drivers in the amount of 6,086 Euros.

In July 2015 SkyToll recorded the total of 15 justified submissions by customers concerning the electronic toll collection operation. They included 9 complaints, 5 requests and 1 suggestion. All the justified submissions were handled within the deadline set out in the contract with the National Motorway Company, which is 5 working days.

Operators of the customer service line of the electronic toll system received over 4.9 thousand calls in July while the toll web portal recorded almost 51.6 thousand visits for the same period.
