

In April the toll collection reached over 12.4 million Euros

Bratislava, 15 May 2012 – **In April 2012 the complex service of electronic toll collection collected the amount of 12.43 million Euros. Compared to April 2011 this amount was almost identical. Just as last year, a decrease of the collected amount compared to March was due to lower intensity of the freight road traffic related to Easter holidays.**

The toll collection for the use of specified road sections of motorways and expressways reached the amount of 8.21 million Euros in April. For the specified sections of 1st class roads it was 4.21 million Euros for the same period. Under the transit ticketing the amount collected for April 2012 was 295,160 Euros. Of the total amount collected almost 43 % was paid by foreign vehicle operators. The day of the month with the highest toll collection was 25th April, when the earned amount reached 610,886 Euros. In April the specified road sections were daily used by 27,153 vehicles over 3.5 tons on average.

The number of active OBUs in the electronic toll system grew again in April. As at the end of the month SkyToll had 203,466 OBUs registered in the system, which month-to-month represents an increase of 1,672 units.

During April the mobile enforcement units checked over 166 thousand vehicles on the specified sections and dealt with 571 cases of violation of Act on Electronic Toll Collection. They collected tolls from drivers in the amount of 17,165 Euros. The share of Slovak drivers of the number of uncovered toll offences was almost 26 % in April. Since the beginning of 2012, the average of Slovak trespassers was over 27%.

In April 2012 SkyToll recorded the total of 266 filings by customers concerning the electronic toll collection operation. Of this number 26 filings were evaluated as justified. In the same month of the last year there were 28 justified filings. Of the justified filings for the month, 11 were claims, 13 requests and 2 suggestions. All claims were handled within the deadline set out in the contract with the National Motorway Company, which is 5 working days.

Operators of the customer service line of the electronic toll system received over 4.2 thousand calls in April while the toll web portal recorded almost 48.7 thousand visits for the same period.
