

## **July toll collection increased month-to-month by 5.91%**

Bratislava, 15 August 2013 – **The complex service of electronic toll collection earned 14.25 million for the National Motorway Company in July 2013. It represents an increase of 791.96 thousand Euros compared to toll collection for July 2012. Compared to June the amount collected in July 2013 was higher by over 765.36 thousand Euros. The total amount collected for seven months of this year reached 90.55 million Euros.**

For the use of specified road sections of motorways and expressways the toll collection generated the amount of 9.26 million Euros in July. For the specified sections of 1<sup>st</sup> class roads it was 4.97 million Euros for the same period. Under the transit ticketing the amount collected for July 2013 was 369,530 Euros. Of the total amount collected 43.19 % was paid by foreign vehicle operators. The day of the month with the highest toll collection was 8<sup>th</sup> July when the government earned 652,101 Euros. In July the specified road sections were daily used by 29,646 vehicles over 3.5 tons on average.

As at 31 July 2013 there were 215,568 OBUs registered in the electronic toll system. Compared to June they increased by 3,010 units. Of the active OBUs 71.20 % were used by foreign vehicles.

In the course of July on the specified road sections the mobile enforcement units dealt with 535 cases of violation of Act on Electronic Toll Collection. They collected tolls from drivers in the amount of 15,413 Euros.

In July 2013 SkyToll recorded the total of 35 justified filings by customers concerning the electronic toll collection operation. Of these 32 were claims and 3 were suggestions. All the received submissions were handled within the deadline set out in the contract with the National Motorway Company, which is 5 working days.

Operators of the customer service line of the electronic toll system received over 3.8 thousand calls in July while the toll web portal recorded almost 61.3 thousand visits for the same period.
