

Toll collection in May was quarter of a million Euros higher compared to April

Bratislava, 15 June 2015 – **The complex service of electronic toll collection earned 15.68 million Euros for the National Motorway Company in May 2015. For the first five months of 2015 a discount on the price of toll was acquired by 13,659 vehicles, of which 11,929 were from Slovakia.**

The specified sections of motorways and expressways earned 9.81 million Euros on toll collection in May. Compared to April the toll collected on motorways and expressways increased by 0.6 percent. The toll collection on specified sections of 1st class roads reached 5.86 million Euros, which compared to the previous month was 3.9 percent more. Of the total collection collection 43.0 percent was paid by foreign vehicle operators. The day of the month with the highest toll collection was 11th May with the collected amount of 758,436 Euros. In May the specified road sections were daily used by 34,590 vehicles over 3.5 tons on average, which represented a decrease of 342 (1%) compared to April 2015.

As at 31 May 2015 there were 249,655 OBUs registered in the electronic toll system. Compared to April their number increased by 2,561 units. Foreign vehicles used 72.2 percent of these. In May on the specified road sections the mobile enforcement units dealt with 567 cases of violation of Act on Electronic Toll Collection. They collected tolls from drivers in the amount of 6,103 Euros.

In May there were 22 justified submissions by customers, of which 19 were claims, 2 requests and 1 suggestion. All the justified submissions were handled within the deadline set out in the contract with the National Motorway Company, which is 5 working days.

Operators of the customer service line of the electronic toll system received over 4.9 thousand calls in May while the toll web portal recorded almost 50.5 thousand visits for the same period.
