

Danish Tax Minister was interested in the Slovak Toll System

Bratislava 4 February (TASR) – Today the Slovak toll system - its development, operation and experience from its implementation - was a point of interest to the Danish tax minister Troels Lund Poulsen during his visit in Bratislava.

Denmark is interested in the implementation of the toll system, said the head of the program for tolling Danish roads Klaus Jensen, who accompanied the minister together with other experts, for TASR. As a result, they are currently looking for possibilities and obtaining experiences in individual countries where the toll system has already been implemented. That is the reason why their journey went through Germany and Austria to Slovakia today and then it continued to the Czech Republic. Denmark, he stressed, has a road network infrastructure similar to that of Slovakia. The first class roads prevail. Currently, payments are effectuated in the form of the so-called road stamps; however the goal is to implement a toll system by 2014. The future form of the system is precisely the purpose of this journey and after evaluating all of the obtained information, they will select a system. In this regard, he praised the complexity and the quality of the information provided by SkyToll.
